NetSetGO Comes to Rossmoyne

The Rossmoyne Netball Club is very excited to be able to offer the extremely successful NetSetGO program for the 2018 season. NetSetGO is a netball program designed specifically for children (both boys and girls) between the ages of 5-10 which aims to provide them with a positive introduction to netball incorporating skill activities, mini games, music, dance and modified matches.

The program is comprised of 3 tiers:

NET – for participants turning 5, 6 and 7 (born 2011-2013)

This will be offered as an 8-week program in Terms 2 and 3 and will take place on Wednesday afternoons at the Koolan Drive courts in Shelley.

Registrations close Tuesday 8th May

SET – for participants turning 8 (born 2010)

This will run for the same duration as our Junior/Senior Winter competition (April – September). The program will be delivered after school on a weekday at the Koolan Drive courts in Shelley and a modified game will take place in Fremantle on Saturdays.

The SET tier replaces the previously named Junior H Grade.

Registrations close Saturday 10th March

GO – for participants turning 9 and 10 (born 2008-2009)

This will run for the same duration as our Junior/Senior Winter competition (April – September). The program will be delivered after school on a weekday at the Koolan Drive courts in Shelley and a modified game will take place in Fremantle on Saturdays.

The GO tier will be offered as GO-G for 9 years old and GO-F for 10 years old. Both replace the previously named Junior G and Junior F Grades.

Registrations close Saturday 10th March

All registered players will receive a pack which includes a t-shirt, netball and activity book.
